# 1. Before You Begin

## Things You'll Need:

- **A Student Account:** You will need a student account to use MyEnglishLab. If you do not have an student account, please contact your administrator or teacher.
- **Your Course ID:** Ask your teacher for their Course ID for you to join the course.




## 2. How to Login and Join a Teacher's Course

In this section, you will learn how to login and join your teacher's course. This would allow your teacher to track your performance and you will be able to see teacher assigned content.

To log in and join a teacher course:

1. Go to <http://www.myenglishlab.com/>
2. Click on **Login**.
3. Enter your **Username** and **Password**.
4. Click on the **Settings** tab. Under **My Courses**, click on **Join a Course**.
5. Enter your teacher's **Course ID**.  
*Note: If you don't have a Course ID, contact your teacher or administrator.*
6. If you have been working on your own and are now joining your teacher's course, click on **Transfer previous practice scores** to transfer your grades to your teacher.
7. Click on **OK**.

## 3. How to Complete Practice Activities

Practice activities are activities that have not been assigned by the teacher and can be used to help you practice the concepts you will learn in each unit.

## How to Complete Practice Activities

Practice activities are activities that have not been assigned by the teacher and can be used to help you practice the concepts you will learn in each unit. You will need to complete all of the practice activities in order to be eligible for the final course test

To complete practice activities:

1. Click on the **Course** tab.
2. Use the **All Courses** button (see red box, in this case *MyEnglishLab Reading Level 3*) to open the menu and choose the course you want to work in.
3. Click on the unit or module desired (see yellow box, in this case comprehension skills).
4. Click on **Open** on the right-hand side of the activity.
5. Complete the practice activity.

## 4. How to Complete Assignments and Tests from Teachers

Your teacher may assign activities and tests to you while others can be done voluntarily as free practice. This section shows you how to complete them.

 **Note:** After your teacher has created an assignment, the assignment will appear on your **To Do List**, **Calendar** and **Recent Activity**.

To complete an assignment:

1. Click on the **Assignments** tab (see red box).
2. Under **To Do List** (see yellow box), you will see your list of assignments. Recent Activity will show what you have done or has expired.
3. Click on **Open** to open the assignment.



## 5. How to Check Your Grades

Most practice activities and assignments are auto-graded, so you will have immediate access to your grades in the **Gradebook**. However, some activities may have to be graded by a teacher, like Speaking and Writing activities.

### Notes:

- *Teacher-graded assignments will not appear in the Gradebook until the assignment has been marked by a teacher.*
- *Speaking and Writing activities completed in self-study or practice mode will not be graded unless assigned by a teacher.*

To check your grades:

1. Click on the **Gradebook** tab (see red box).
2. Select your course from the **Change course** drop-down list (see yellow box).
3. Grades will appear under the **Data** tab (see green box).
4. The default view of the Gradebook is **Assignment and Tests**. To view grades for practice activities, select an option from **Change view** (see blue box).
